# 2020 ZCFA PARADE

## Saturday, March 14, 2020

### Rules & Regulations

1. The entry form and liability release form must be received by the Chamber of Commerce office **NO LATER than Tuesday, March 10, 2020 by 5:00 pm** to participate. Application must include a signature of all participant names.
2. Line-up will start by **7:30 AM** and all entries must be in line **NO LATER THAN 8:30 AM**.
3. **Make sure to get your designated number to participate and map lineup by Wednesday, March 11, 2020. VERY IMPORTANT: PLEASE REVIEW YOUR LOCATION LINE-UP AND HOW TO GET TO YOUR LOCATION, INFORMATION IS PROVIDED ON THE BACK OF YOUR NUMBER CARD. MAKE SURE THAT PARENTS ARE AWARE OF THE LOCATION LINEUP AND LOCATION ROUTE. THIS WILL HELP KEEP THE TRAFFICE CONTROL BETTER.**
4. Drivers of vehicles must be licensed and insured as prescribed by the Texas Dept. of Public Safety
5. Public officials will ride the parade in representation of their elected public office. Campaigning is not allowed.
6. There will be **NO EARLY EXITS** from parade route. No one will be allowed to get on or off an entry after the parade has stepped off.
7. **NO THROWING** - PLEASE do not throw candy or other items from your float. You may have individuals walk along your float and hand or toss candy/prizes to those along the sidewalks.
8. Children age 12 and under **MAY NOT** walk outside an entry/float, they must be in automobile or float unless they are part of a walking unit.
9. Trophies for different categories will be issued and will be awarded at the county fairgrounds at 1:30 P.M. Participants will abide by the final decision of the judges.
10. Drivers will not swerve off the highway or side to side. Everyone will follow a straight line-up and will drive at the required speed limit. There will be no passing of floats or vehicles during the parade.
11. Car clubs will be allowed to enter three (3) of their show cars (this includes representation from car wash businesses, body shops, etc.)
12. Motorcycle clubs are allowed in groups of six. If there are more entries, they will be placed in different sections of the parade. Motorcycle drivers are not allowed to get close to the edge of the highway where the audience is present. No swerving and no passing cars or floats.

### Parade Information:

The parade will **START PROMPTLY AT 9:00 AM** on 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave. (Pepe's Car Wash) and head North on U.S. Hwy 83 taking a right on 23<sup>rd</sup> Ave. to end the parade.
